Some important notes for our new members -

If you are new to flying, we welcome you to the fraternity. Hopefully, you have always been fascinated by planes, the thoughts of being able to soar with the birds, and not afraid to try something new.

Here are some things you need to know, whether new to flying or not;

You can get assistance in learning to fly. We have instructors who will gladly help you or your family members. **DO NOT TRY TO FLY YOUR MODEL WITHOUT INSTRUCTION! YOU ARE GUARANTEED TO CRASH!**

If you do have some flying experience, we ask that you demonstrate your level of skill to one of the instructors before flying by yourself at the field. Nothing more than a single demonstration flight is required before we “turn you loose.”

If you need assistance or guidance in decisions about purchasing a model or materials, just let us know. We can suggest a model that you will enjoy flying and that will last you (hopefully) a long, long time. Don't buy little small plastic type models! It's a waste of money!

Please ask for (if you join) a roster of current members and a copy of the by-laws in case I forget to give these to you. You should read carefully the club rules and be very familiar with the AMA safety code.

If you have not joined AMA yet, you will need to do so before flying! However, there is a program for NEW PILOTS that will allow us to begin teaching you for up to 30 days while you get your AMA number. It requires an instructor to be with you at all times. Ask about the AMA INTRO PILOT program.

Before flying again, always ask if others are (a) waiting for your frequency pin and (b) that if 3 others are flying that you see if someone else is waiting (4 max)

LASTLY, NEVER, NEVER, BUT NEVER TURN ON A TRANSMITTER WHEN AT THE FIELD WITHOUT THE PIN FOR THAT FREQUENCY! IT WILL SURELY CAUSE A CRASH FOR ANYONE WHO IS IN THE AIR ON YOUR SAME FREQUENCY. ALWAYS PUT YOUR RADIO IN THE RACK WHEN ARRIVING AT THE FIELD AND DON'T TAKE IT OUT WITHOUT THE PIN (UNTIL LEAVING THE FIELD.) THANKS!
